The 2011 Lake Tahoe Concours d' Elegance was again a resounding success. The Tahoe Yacht Club Foundation and Sierra Boat Company host this world class event each year. Our RCUSA annual dinner was hosted at Garwood's restaurant during wooden boat week with over 70 members in attendance.

The Riva Historical Society (RHS), which is the parent organization to our own RCUSA, hosted the RHS Venice days reunion of Riva boats in Venice Italy in June of this year. David and Diane Paul, Eric Thearling, Dirk Reed and Linda Rhodes attended this wonderful event in grand style touring the canals and open waters of the Venice area. It was a unique opportunity to interact with other RHS members from all over Europe.

For 2012, the Lake Tahoe Concours d' Elegance will be celebrating the 50th anniversary of the Riva Aquarama and the 90th birthday of Carlo Riva himself.

We have many festivities planned around this event and encourage all of our members to keep up to date with our website as we add details, dates and a schedule of events. Save the dates for August 9-10-11. This event will surely be the largest display of Riva Aquarama's in one place. There are many other RCUSA events that are scheduled in the days following the Concours.

Following this event is the European celebration of the 50th anniversary and birthday on the shores of Lake Iseo in Northern Italy. This event will be celebrated in grand style near the location of the original Riva factory in Sarnico, Italy beginning on August 30 through September 3rd, 2012.

By now, you should have received information regarding this event from RHS in Italy.

This year, because of increased costs the RCUSA member-dues have been increased slightly from \$100 to \$125 USD in order to meet with increased costs of operation. Or fees paid to the RHS have increased. These same dues pay for the Viva Riva publication and the RHS annual calendar. Another extra benefit of membership includes a 10% discount with Hagerty Insurance.

All Riva Club members are invited to participate in the Riva Historical Society (RHS) **Carlo Riva Plaque** Registration program, through our Chapter, Riva Club USA (RCUSA). Two Carlo Riva plaques, one for the boat and one for display, will be awarded to each Riva boat whose owner presents, along with the registration fee, proper photographs of their boat and copies of any relevant documentation establishing their Riva as an original product of the Shipyard Riva.

Additionally, RHS plans on including photographs of all registered Rivas in a book to commemorate Carlo Riva's 90th birthday.

The RCUSA Board of Directors has appointed Herb Hall and Alan Weinstein as Commissioners for the Carlo Riva Plaque program. It is the Commissioners responsibility to verify the supplied information and to register each boat with RHS in Italy.

To enroll in this program, please provide the following;

A. Boat data: Model, year of build, hull number, vessel name, and five (5) photographs of: 1- front/side, 2 -back/side with cockpit in view, 3 - dashboard, 4 - hull number, 5 - the engine (s). If sending photos via email, please make sure they are in JPEG format

B. A check made out to RCUSA in the amount of \$250.00.

Events will include lunches & dinners with other RHS members and the Riva family, tours of the Riva Factory, Navigation and Piloting competitions, picnics on the lake, classic race-boat displays and many other wonderful attractions.

Sign up deadline is July 30, 2012 with a discount offered if you sign up before December 15, 2011. Cost of participation is Euro €350 for early registration, €400 after Dec 15.

We encourage you to register early and also to arrive with a bit of advance timing so that you can get acclimated to your wonderful surroundings in Northern Italy and minimize the impact of jet-lag on your experiences.
