WELCOME TO ROSLAGEN!

The northern part of Stockholm archipelago



Roslagen is unique by its thousands of islands and waterways. Here we find an archipelago with a bit different beauty as the open sea comes closer than in the southern archipelago. Here residents on the islands was fishing heering and hunting seals to become a living besides being small-scale farmers.

During the alcohol restriction period in the 30s this was the smuggler's paradise. When Finland and Sweden belonged together the traderoute between them passed through this area, therefore it became a marketplace for merchandise and it was from this region the navy picked the best seamen for their warships.

During the big Nordic war the Russians came over in 1709 and burned down most of the old villages and houses along the coastline. In the early 1900 many painters and writers found it a perfect place to be creative due to the beauty and peacefulness up here.

PROGRAM

Sunday 16 July

Today's expedition heading south, towards the more central parts of Stockholm archipelago. We will get lunch during the way before turning back. Route depending on sea and weather conditions.

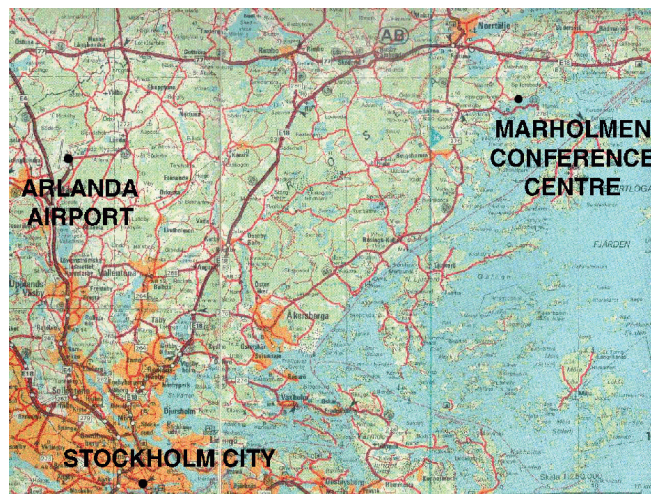

Fuel for boats

The closest gas station by sea is about 20-30 minutes away, Furusund or Gräddö.

Best is to fill up before bringing the boat to water, we recommend Norrtälje. It is cheaper and saves time.

We expect all participants to have a full tank when we start the meeting on Friday morning.

The total distance during these days will be approximately 110 Nm.
